The following content offers an overview of activities on the Alberta and Canadian bicycling scene:

- **City of Calgary** has republished in hardcopy, its <u>Pathway and Bikeway map</u>. The 2024 2025 version replaces the paper map last offered in 2021.
- <u>Calgary Mountain Bike Alliance</u> past and new / on-going trail building initiatives here.
- Youth En Route (YEN). A Calgary based program encouraging students to bicycle to school. Success stories here.
- City of Edmonton has introduced two programs to encourage bicycling:
 Join a City-guided Ride-Along "Join the City's Bike Education Street Team on rides hosted across Edmonton" and City Joy Rides "The City has created cycling routes and loops from 7 to 40 km long. Download offline maps with the mobile app, or access PDF maps."
- **Bike Edmonton** South community bike shop closed on 16 June'24. Downtown shop remains open.
- Edmonton Mountain Bike Alliance September '24 newsletter is here. Funding has been awarded for construction of Edmonton's first bike park. Some fundraising is still required and permit applications are in progress
- City of Lethbridge <u>bicycling info page</u>.
- <u>Town of Edson's</u> 2023 Transportation Study, draft, pages 17 26 includes plans for bicycling infrastructure. Search "Transportation Study" on Edson's website.

Blacksmith shop volunteers agreed to add rack enhancements. Demonstrates forging valuable cooperation between PA and Meadowlark Trail volunteers.
